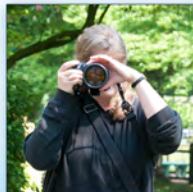
ABOUT US

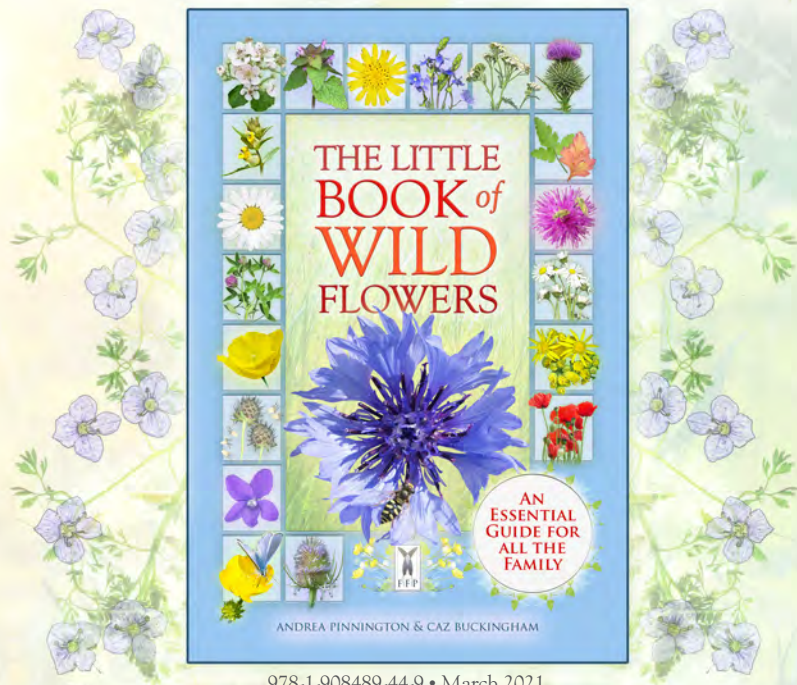

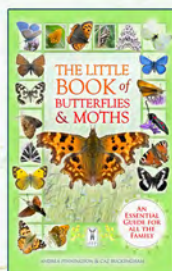

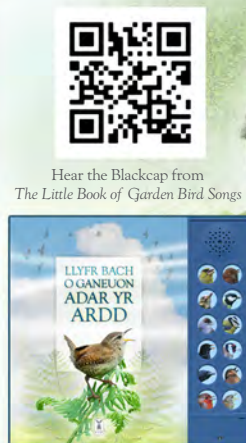

Feeling Hungry takes a gently humorous look at the thorny issue of mealtimes through the world of animals and helps to promote healthy and positive attitudes towards food.

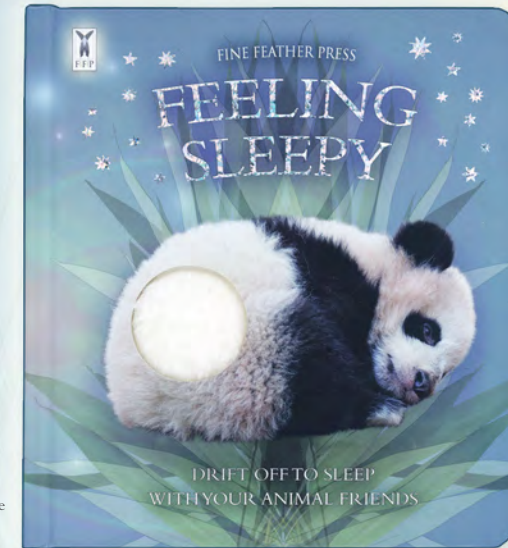

FEELING SLEEPY

Feeling Sleepy is based on effective relaxation techniques for toddlers, helping to make going to bed a calming daily ritual. Children are encouraged to copy the animal babies as they take them on a journey through some basic meditation principles. These help to unbusy the brain and encourage the children to fall asleep.

The rhyming text helps to lull and soothe as well as promoting early reading skills while the touch-and-feel elements help to build an association between looking at the book and going to sleep.

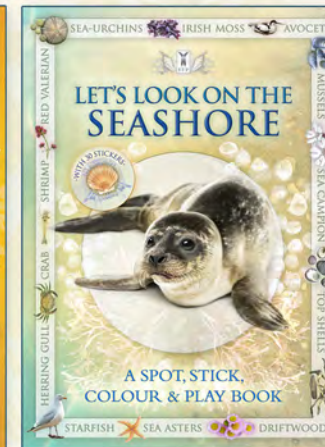

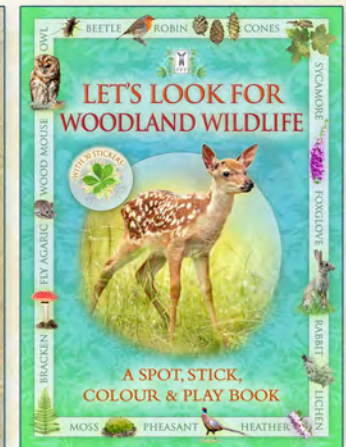

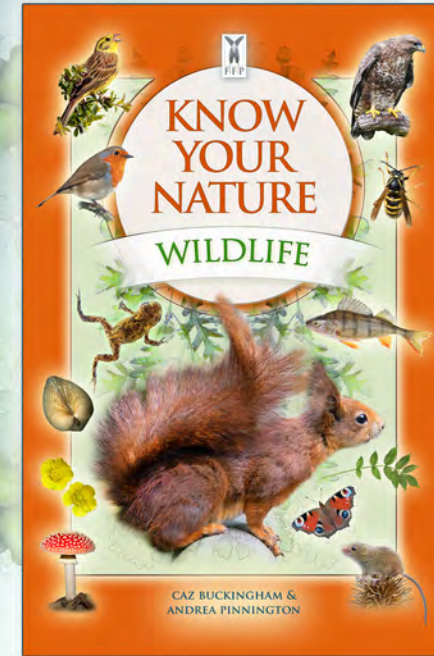
WHAT'S THAT GARDEN BIRD?

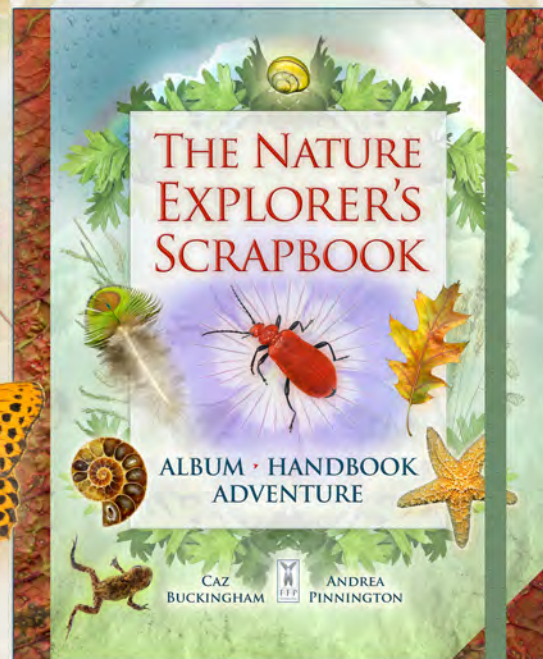
